



Golf Cart Zone Announcement

Please Note: Carts are not authorized to drive on the roads without being inspected and registered as described below. With the new law in effect, you should expect stricter enforcement of unlawful driving of carts on the roads.

We are pleased to announce that the new Grant county Golf Cart Zone Ordinance has been passed and is ready to be implemented. The initial ordinance was unacceptable and included many additional requirements not included in the state law. Due to the actions of the DAOA Board and the Sunland Estates Board, we were successful in getting the county to agree in following the state law guidelines and not add further restrictive provisions and requirements.

Requirements:

-Seat Belts- anchored to the frame for driver and passenger

-Two rear view mirrors- one on the left hand side of the cart and one on either the right hand side or in the middle

-Reflectors- right and left side, front and rear of the cart, eight 3” reflectors, four amber and four red. The two amber facing forward on the front left and right sides, two amber on the front sides facing right and left, two red facing to the rear on the rear right and left and two red on the rear sides facing right and left.

Inspection:

-Carts must be inspected for the above and registered prior to driving on the road

-Owner must be present for inspection and registration

-Owner must have cart ID number or VIN number

-Owner must provide proof of ownership if available or Driver License

-Owner must present driver license as ID

Fees:

Inspection - \$15

Registration - \$35 – Decal will be issued

Payment must be cash or check. No credit cards will be accepted.
