

Minutes of November 12, 2010 Parks, Marina and Greenbelt Committee

The November 12, 2010 meeting of the Parks, Marina and Greenbelt Committee was held downstairs in the Desert Aire Multipurpose Building. In attendance were Committee members Doug Shore, Dick Dorton, Terry Jensen, Gary Varney, James Curdy, and Chairman Bob Kibler. Also in attendance were residents Steve and Darlene Bodin.

The Shoreline Plan update was delivered to Bob by email, from Igor Shaporda: "The application packet was received from our consultants and currently is being finalized by internal PUD staff. We anticipate submitting the application to the local, state and federal agencies next week."

Work on the new tennis courts has been concluded for this year. We must wait for warmer weather next spring before the surfacing for the asphalt can be applied and lines painted.

James presented a worksheet for a discussion of four possible options on running the River Campground. The PUD is not ready to start negotiating on this subject, but we wanted to get our priorities out front for ourselves in this in-house discussion. A lively talk took place among people in attendance about the various options presented, including the pros and cons of each. The subject consumed most of the time for this meeting.
