Chemical Technician

Description:

Under the direction of the Assistant Superintendent performs routine manual labor involved in golf course and grounds maintenance. Does skilled grounds construction and maintenance work, operates all hand-powered equipment and regularly performs chemical applications on project properties including but not limited to: golf course, parks, greenbelts and airport. Can perform or assist with most any area of maintenance.

Typical Tasks:

Performs pesticide applications utilizing mechanically pressurized and hand operated sprayers. Maintains chemical application records current and the chemical storage and mixing areas in a neat and orderly fashion so as to comply with all county, state and federal regulations.

Also maintains Safety Data Sheets(SDS) listings.

May help with or make fertilizer applications.

Grounds maintenance personnel are to report any irregularities in course turf or plant quality to the Assistant Grounds Superintendent and/or Superintendent.

Employment Standards:

Must have a current WA ST Private/Commercial Pesticide Applicators License.

Requires working knowledge of chemical application equipment and the ability to follow written and oral directions.

Also ability to schedule and check efficiency of said applications.

No physical limitations with respect to normal manual labor, such as lifting, digging, etc.

Ability to bend, stoop, and lift up to 70 lbs.

Should be able to obtain a First Aid Card.
